## 1960 - 1961 TIGER-CATS TEAM ISSUE

In 1960 the Tiger-Cats switched to a smaller format for their media photos and the 1961 photos were issued in the exact same format so they are listed together here. Photos with the older style uniform with the three stripes on the shoulders can be dated to 1960 (as per the Moulton photo) and photos with the new style uniforms were taken in 1961 (as per the Taylor photo).


Topps used a handful of the new 1961 uniform photos for their Hamilton cards in the 1962 issue.





Cards have been listed alphabetically with notes on differences where known and year if confirmed. Also listed separately are the four known double card configurations as they appeared in the programs, with program date where available. The set total applies to cards from all years together and the intact program pair format totals only apply to the known pairs. The pairs have been priced at roughly 110% of the separated singles and the pair listings are more to help determine which cards were issued when. The value of intact programs from these seasons will be catalogued in a future volume.

It may be that cards from different programs are slightly different in size, this is also unconfirmed. Sizes vary slightly from picture to picture in any case.
